Abstract

Studying job satisfaction has had a long history in the field of Industrial and Organizational Psychology. Few studies about part- time job satisfaction have been done in Hong Kong, however. The purpose of this study was to examine the relationship between Type A personality, neuroticism and the level of part-time job satisfaction of Hong Kong's university students. One hundred and two university students participated in this study. A regression analysis showed that neuroticism was negatively correlated with job satisfaction. However, no significant relationship was found between Type A personality and level of part-time job satisfaction.
